

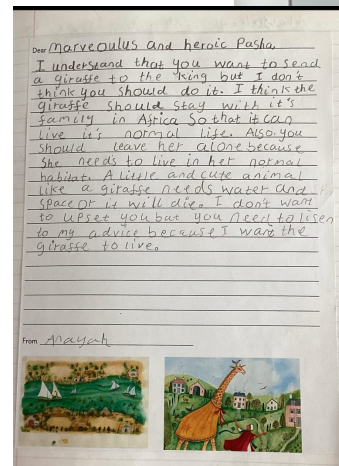
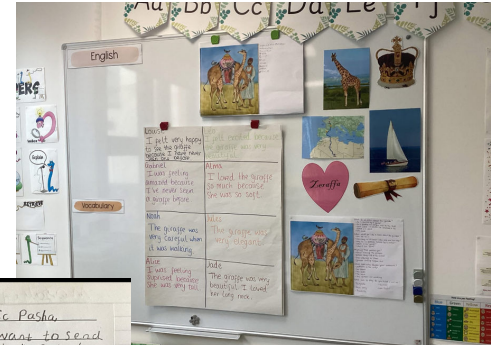

Times Table Rock Stars and Numbots

The children are doing really well at learning their 2, 5 and 10 times tables. We can see that their practice on TTRS has really supported them in school. We are practicing daily at school. We recommend that the children do little but often - 5 minutes a day is much better than 30 minutes once a week.
